Criteria for Ordinary Membership (Article 7)

Every candidate for election as an Ordinary Member shall be resident in Hong Kong and shall be not less than 21 years of age and shall comply with one of the following conditions:

- (a) that he is a person on a Register of Patent Agents or Patent Attorneys or Trade Mark Agents or Trade Mark Attorneys in any relevant jurisdiction (as determined by the Council) and who has been practising trade mark law for at least two years of which at least six months practice has been in Hong Kong and a substantial part of which practice in Hong Kong has been in Hong Kong trade mark law; or
- (b) that he is a solicitor or barrister entitled to practice in Hong Kong and who has been practising trade mark law to a substantial extent for two or more years of which at least six months practice has been in Hong Kong and a substantial part of which practice in Hong Kong has been in Hong Kong trade mark law; or
- (c) that he is qualified by examination to practice trade mark law in any relevant jurisdiction (as determined by the Council) and who has been practising trade mark law to a substantial extent for two or more years of which at least six months practice has been in Hong Kong and a substantial part of which practice in Hong Kong has been in Hong Kong trade mark law; or
- (d) that he is a former official of the Hong Kong Trade Marks Registry with five or more years of experience at the grade of "Assistant Registrar 1" or above as defined by the Hong Kong Government; or
- (e) that he has passed all Parts of the Institute's Entrance Examination ("Certificate in Hong Kong Trade Mark Law and Practice" issued by the School of Professional and Continuing Education of the University of Hong Kong or any other such examination as may be decided from time to time by Council) and has worked in practice in Hong Kong for two or more years with a Founder Member or Ordinary Member who is wholly or principally engaged in the practice of Hong Kong trade mark law; or
- (f) that he has been practising trade mark law in Hong Kong to a substantial extent for at least five years and a substantial part of which practice in Hong Kong has been in Hong Kong trade mark law and who the Council may at their absolute discretion admit to membership."

Criteria for Junior Membership (Article 8)

Junior Members shall comprise those persons who, at the date of adoption of these Articles are on the Register as Junior Members of the Institute and every person thereafter elected as such.

The Council may elect as a Junior Member any person who is sponsored by a Founder or Ordinary Member and has for at least three months been (i) an assistant of a Founder or Ordinary Member, or (ii) a person employed in the office of a Trade Mark Agent or Patent Agent and who is wholly or principally engaged in trade mark work, or other intellectual property law, namely patents, copyright or designs, but the Council shall have the power to elect as a Junior Member any other candidate whom it considers eligible.

Criteria for In-House Membership (Article 10B)

In-House Members comprise those persons who at the date of adoption of these Articles are on the Register as In-House Members and every person thereafter elected as such.

Every candidate for election as an In-House Member shall be not less than 21 years of age, shall be ordinarily resident in Hong Kong and shall prove to the satisfaction of the Council that he has (for such period as the Council may prescribe) practiced either as (a) a trade mark practitioner to a reasonable extent, or(b) a solicitor or barrister, or lawyer in any relevant jurisdiction (as determined by Council) but who has not necessarily practiced trade mark law. In either case such person should now be engaged with a role which includes the handling of intellectual property matters in a company whose business is other than the offering of intellectual property services to the public. A candidate for election as an In-House Member shall be sponsored by two Ordinary Members and shall in the opinion of the Council be of good repute.

Criteria for Student Membership (Article 10H)

Student Members shall comprise those persons who, at the date of adoption of these Articles are on the Register as Student Members and every person thereafter elected as such. The Council may elect as a Student Member any person who is not less than 18 years of age and shall prove to the satisfaction of the Council that he is engaged in full-time or part-time study of law at a university in Hong Kong, or such study is with a recognized overseas university but the person is a resident of Hong Kong, and such person expresses an interest to pursue a career in intellectual property law in Hong Kong upon conclusion of such study.
